

Nesting Performance 2004



Analysis: 2004 was an eventful year with a number of new volunteers and somewhat colder, wetter weather than normal.

About 79% of the boxes were in use, compared with 75% last season. Overall egg production was up, but only 56% resulted in fledged birds. In 2003, 88% of eggs resulted in fledged birds. It appears there were many failed nesting attempts. With cracked eggs and abandonment, there may be several possible causes including weather, predation and undue human influence. Human influence has not been a problem in the past given our monitoring regimen (weekly). Since all of our monitors receive training (classroom and field), their techniques are similar, and even with a large number of new volunteers, probably is not a significant factor. Weather certainly was poor with temperatures reaching the 50s and 60s over multiple days. This was likely a contributing factor, but probably not the only one. Predation has always been a challenge to the team, and a renegade House Wren is not altogether out of the question given their known behavior.
